ARCHITECTS REGISTRATION BOARD

REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Possess a degree, diploma or other qualification in architecture granted by a university of school of architecture that, in the opinion of the Board, is evidence of satisfactory training in architecture; **or**
- 2. Is registered as an architect by a board, council or institute in a country other than Barbados and where in the opinion of the Board, the overseas body upholds satisfactory standards of architecture; **and**
- 3. Has not less than 3 years of such practical experience in architecture as the Board approves.

Supporting Documentation Required

- i) Proof of academic qualifications original certificates or notarized copies signed by parliamentary representative, senior government official, attorney, clergyman or justiceof-peace.
 - ii) Job Verification Letters Confirming periods of employment and associated tasks and responsibilities: should be signed and sealed by a registered architect.
 - iii) Detailed Resume detailing past employers, job descriptions, employment periods, etc.
 - iv) Proof of Nationality National Identification Card; Passport
 - v) proof of Immigration Status (if applicable) Work Permit and/or other legal document.
 - vi) Proof of Registration as an Architect outside of Barbados (if applicable). Note that an official letter must be sent from the registration board directly to the ARB.
